Good steer entries sailed to 253p/kg or to £1579 per head. More commercial steers harder work this week.

Butchers heifers still in strong demand to 257p/kg with a few heavy females penned selling to £1350 per head.

Some well finished bulls entered this morning saw best sucklers to 228p/kg, with heavier Continentals to £1596 in the lump. Black and whites bulls a great go selling to 183p/kg. Only one cow forward saw a Limousin cross cow selling to 116p/kg for 608kg.
