A good post festivity entry met a firm trade despite Mr Johnson's Monday evening 'lockdown' announcement. There were some very well finished cattle forward which were a credit to all the producers once again. Several 'first timers' in attendance today, seeing the light coming from the 'darkside'. Our overall average on bulls and clean was 210p/kg, with cattle ranging from 103p/kg to 289p/kg!

Steers were short in number with the best shapes on the lean side. Limousins sold to 250p/kg for the last beast in the market or £1,540 in the lump.

Heifers averaged 225p/kg on the lot to an overall high of 289p/kg with several butcher's beasts over 270p/kg. Well finished heavy females selling particularly well today to £1,630 in the lump.

More bulls penned this morning helped filling regular orders. Trade was great with Continentals selling to 230p/kg on two occasions with heavies adding up nicely to nearly £1,700. Not the greatest sample of Friesian/Holsteins today in strong demand to 184p/kg.

11 STEERS SOLD TO OV.AV. 208P/KG

616kg Limousins from traveller Phil Davies sold to 250p/kg to head the bullock section, with shapey Piedmontese crosses to 240p/kg for 538kg. Handy-weight Limmies sold to 230p/kg for 470kg from John Westwood.

82 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 225P/KG

Some red spark in the heifer section saw early riser Andrew Bishop selling this super Limmie heifers to 289p/kg with others to 278p/kg and 273p/kg from the same home. Richard Parkes normal quality sailed to second spot at 286p/kg for 486kg with other handy weights to 275p/kg and 265p/kg. 478kg Limmies from Roger Jordin also in this price bracket to 271p/kg. Heavier Continentals were a revelation from the Dalton's selling 604kg to 270p/kg and 608kg to 268p/kg (£1,630 in the lump!). John Elgin's grand run of Conti heifers also in the £1 seats, selling to £1,617 for 632kg.

52 BULLS SOLD TO OV.AV 187P/KG

Bull trade was sharp with few best types about. Homebred Limousins sold to 230p/kg for 738kg from David Preece, with others to the same for 604kg from Richard Yates (The Preeces' bull failed to reach £1,700 by £2.60!). Heavy dairy bred Lims added up for Bill Yeomans at £1,554.74 for 814kg Limousin crosses. Bazadaise bulls sold to 226p/kg for Martin Faulconbridge's run with his heavies to £1,537.38 for 702kg.

Useful black & white numbers penned this morning met a strong level of demand, selling to 184p/kg from Mark Lloyd, with Richard Yates and Colin Evans achieving 180p/kg for their dairy bulls

A larger entry of hoggs, the exact opposite of the national trend, with large numbers presented before the 31st December deadline reducing supply in January.

Those who gambled on the deal/no deal benefited with trade averaging 250p/kg, the dearest since pre lockdown last March.

Clean, dry presentable sheep most definitely the order of the day, with abattoirs experiencing major difficulties in processing dirty animals. With the current situation, it has NEVER been more important to present your sheep CLEAN. Customers are prepared to pay but are finding it problematical when dirty sheep arrive in abattoirs, unable to process or slowing the lines to half speed.

A top price this week of 290p/kg from Pete Morris 41kg Beltex and £130.50 from Richard Morgan. All the top prices per kilo being belly clipped or clean dry lambs. Heavier sheep sold to 250p/kg for 48½kg Beltex from James Cork with plenty of 46kg plus hoggs over 240p/kg and 49½kg to 229p/kg from Brian Williams.

With local wholesalers expecting another lockdown, trade on butcher's lambs very firm with plenty of 36kg to 39kg lambs to 250p/kg to 269p/kg. Lighter hoggs 34kg sold to 255p/kg Beltex and hill lambs 32kg at 244p/kg from Roddy Yapp.
