

# BRIDGNORTH LIVESTOCK MARKET WEEKLY REPORT – 08.12.20



## 136 PRIME CATTLE

Quality was the name of the game today with retail butchers experiencing increased footfall before the Christmas festivities – great to see! Looking at our headline prices, you may be fooled in thinking this was show day, but that was last Tuesday! Prices nearing £3 per kilo were seen today, with producers putting some tremendous cattle, especially heifers, in front of our regular buyer contingent.

No best steers forward this morning saw the tidiest Continentals available to 224p/kg with plenty of lean, bellied sorts otherwise pulling averages down.

A supersonic entry of females sold accordingly with two stars selling above 290p/kg to a top of 295p/kg. Heavy females a very dear trade all through, selling to £1603 in the lump. Heifers over 260p/kg did not appear in the top ten prices today.

Bull numbers were disappointing, as was quality, with mainly Holstein or dairy crosses penned. The black & white trade was sharp with well finished Friesian/Holsteins past 180p/kg regularly to 188p/kg. No best sucklers sold to 213p/kg. At least 50 bulls are required each week.

Only 4 cows forward which were also non-assured and sold to 100p/kg for 698kg Angus cross. Cow trade not too sharp.

## 94 CLEAN CATTLE

**ONLY 11 STEERS SOLD TO OV.AV. 185P/KG**

The Jordin Bros blasted this section achieving 249p/kg for their 644kg young Limmie (£1603.56). Phillip Corfield's Blondes took second spot at 224p/kg for 620kg, closely followed by Millichamp Bros selling their 616kg Blonde to 221p/kg and Frank Davenports 618kg Simmental cross selling to 206p/kg. More steers required but they must be well finished.

**85 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 232P/KG**

The average says it all but does hide plain heifers at 100p/kg on two occasions and Angus crosses at 170p/kg.

A great run of Continentals from Richard Parkes sailed to a high of 295p/kg for 482kg Limmie with others to 268p/kg, 266p/kg, 263p/kg and 260p/kg. Second spot was Evans (Curdale) selling their best to 293p/kg for 504kg Limousin with others to 282p/kg, 281p/kg, 280p/kg, 271p/kg and 268p/kg. Heavier 556kg Limousins from Robert Morris sold to 274p/kg (£1523.44). Andrew Bishop sold his handyweights both to 270p/kg with his last heavier Limmie to 272p/kg for 562kg (£1528.64). Roger Jordin sold his Limousin heifers to 270p/kg, with Andrew Craig to 269p/kg at Lot 3. Mrs B had a decent day selling to 268p/kg and 267p/kg for 504kg and 508kg respectively.



## ONLY 42 BULLS SOLD TO OV.AV 179P/KG

After last week, show quality was severely missing today but a great trade persisted from start to finish. The first bulls in the ring from Dickie Price topped at 213p/kg for 624kg Limousins, with another to 210p/kg. 564kg Simmental crosses from Graham Williams sold to 204p/kg for 564kg. Charlie Lloyd's handyweights sold nicely to 206p/kg for 514kg Montbeliarde with a Limmie to 205p/kg for 490kg.

Friesians topped at 188p/kg from the Beaumont stable, also selling to 187p/kg. 616kg Norwegians sold to 181p/kg from Bob Mayer.

A larger entry with trade firmer averaging 224p/kg, customers keen to purchase lambs of all grades and weight with every pen attracting spirited bidding and keen competition. Best lambs dealer to 251p/kg for 47kg lambs from Roger Hillage, whose entry of lambs averaged 47.2kg and just shy of 230p/kg and £108 to a top of £117.20.

Plenty of lambs well over £100 with the optimum weights of 46kg to 49kg realising the higher prices per head and lambs over 50kg generally lower prices per kilo and £104. More quality lambs could easily be sold every week with retail trade demanding a quality product. Lambs under 35kg to 229p/kg from Dave Green and hill-bred lambs 31½kg to 222p/kg.

With the current trade for lambs, more sheep required next week to meet the current strong buying support.
