It was great to see trade holding up well, with Covid lockdown causing logistic problems but not dampening the price. Perhaps not quite the heady heights of last Tuesday on the best cattle, but as a yard of beasts, they sold to a fair trade.

More steers penned this morning with best shapes selling to 250p/kg and to £1645 in the lump. Well finished bullocks attracted plenty of interest.

Our heifer entry was sprinkled with stardust, but there were also several runs of more commercial types and overagers. Best butchers cattle sold to a high of 266p/kg, with 5 others past 260p/kg. Less handy-weight cattle forward generally. Heavy females sold to £1638.36.

More bulls forward but quality was very limited. A strong level of demand throughout, with suckler bulls selling to 231p/kg or £1574 in the lump. Several consignments of Holsteins met a sharp trade to 184p/kg. Any bulls with meat were easy to sell

6 COWS SOLD TO OV. AV. 113P/KG

Cow trade is on the up as numbers have been tight nationally. British Blue crosses sold to 130p/kg for 698kg, with 686kg Limousin crosses to 127p/kg.

A super run of homebred Limousin crosses from Gordon & Chris Jones sold to 250p/kg and 249p/kg both 658kg, the best adding up to £1645 in the lump. Handy-weight Blonde steers from Rob Lilley topped at 249p/kg, with 644kg Limmies to 240p/kg from the Dalton stable. British Blues sold to 238p/kg from Rita Corfield-McCowan.

83 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 218P/KG

Last man in topped the day with Marcus Whitehouse's Limousin cross heifer selling to 266p/kg for 490kg. 585kg British Blues from Rob Morris took second spot at 265p/kg, with Richard Parkes selling the best of his heifers to 264p/kg for 518kg. Rob Amphlett sold his quick Limmie to 262p/kg with Blues from Mrs B to 260p/kg. Heavy Limousins from the Dalton stable sold to £1638.36 for 666kg. Once again, heavy meated heifers seeing strong demand.

67 BULLS SOLD TO OV.AV 185P/KG

A great average considering a strong Holstein influence penned this morning.

Richard Price's fit Limousins sold to 231p/kg for 600kg and 228p/kg for 630kg. 706kg Limmies from Dave Preece added up nicely at £1574.35 (223p/kg) with Nigel Lloyd selling his to 221p/kg for 638kg Limousin.

Several runs of Holsteins forward saw Colin Evans selling his black & whites to 184p/kg.

A large show of hoggs averaging 267p/kg and selling to over £3/kg, with 43kg to 303p/kg from Richard Morgan and £142.70 for 51½kg.

Once again, clean, belly clipped hoggs sold to a premium with abattoirs experiencing problems with wet, dirty hoggs. That said, this would be the best trade for some time. All hoggs over 44kg averaged £125.50. The wholesale average was £111.58 and with wholesalers generally busy, the only downside being exporters are struggling with the mass of paperwork now involved in exporting to the European Union

Heavy hoggs sold to 256p/kg for 52%kg from Alan Jones, 49kg to 280p/kg from Pete Levi and 36kg to 42kg hoggs in short supply and easily sold around 260p/kg to 280p/kg. Lighter hill sheep a mind blowing trade with 32kg at 259p/kg and Beltex 33kg to 274p/kg.


