A small entry with most buyers' busy selling meat. Trade was fair without being exceptional. Well-finished cattle easiest sold as expected with steers selling to 220p/kg and heifers to 259p/kg.

2 Blonde steers sold to a high of 220p/kg from Millichamp Bros or £1478.40 in the lump, with his other to 186p/kg for less shape but more weight.

36 heifers met a fair trade for the goods, selling to 259p/kg and 257p/kg for handy-weight Limousins from Richard Parkes, with two others to 250p/kg from Evans (Curdale). Overall heifer average to 204p/kg, including overage fat Herefords at 90p/kg.

Normal Prime Market next Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> December 2020. Good entries of clean cattle and bulls required. A strong buyer contingent anticipated, including butchers.

With the weekend's disruption surrounding shipping meat to the continent, numbers forward in markets nationally have been well down and deadweight centres, as you would expect, have taken the opportunity to reduce prices by up to 50p/kg.

Trade in auction markets at worst have held firm and in many cases showing improvement, with Bridgnorth averaging a very healthy 234p/kg to 255p/kg for 41kg Texels from Plymouth Estates on three occasions.

Commercial export spec sheep were extremely dear, with heavier 46kg lambs to 238p/kg and 54½kg at 216p/kg and £117.75.

A real shortage of lighter weights, with 35kg to 235p/kg and Welsh tup lambs 29½kg at 210p/kg.
