Icy back-roads kept some vendors away today but those that braved the conditions were very well rewarded – a fantastic trade throughout with well finished cattle in front of the buyers once again. More clean and bulls could have easily sold today with orders left partially filled.

A sprinkling of steers with quality more than quantity today, selling to 259p/kg with heavy Continentals to £1,643 in the lump.

Not so many show stoppers forward in the heifer department saw the cream selling to 280p/kg with a sharp trade on heavier bodies to £1,614.

Bull trade lifted 10-15p/kg from last week's cooler breeze but with generally a lack of quality bulls forward. A very strong Holstein influence, hence an average of 181p/kg. Heavy Continental bulls sold to £1,539 in the lump with 232p/kg taking the headlines. Black & white bulls saw very strong competition to 190p/kg.

2 overage Dexter cross steers sold to 100p/kg & 70p/kg for 390kg and 284kg respectively.

#### ONLY 10 STEERS FORWARD SOLD TO OV.AV. 225P/KG

Handyweight Limousin crosses from Evans (Curdale) topped here at 259p/kg for 540kg, with other Limmies from the Jordin brothers at 628kg to 256p/kg (£1,607). Mr B's slick Blonde sold to 252p/kg for 634kg (£1,597) with two Limmies from Simon Raybould to £1,642 & £1,630.

#### 54 HEIFERS FORWARD SOLD TO OV. AV. 232P/KG

Evans (Curdale) were top dogs here also selling their run of ten to 280p/kg with others of note to 272p/kg, 270p/kg and 261p/kg. 538kg Limmies from Richard Parkes took second spot to 275p/kg with others to 271p/kg and 261p/kg. Limmies from Mrs B sold to 260p/kg for 520kg with Charlie Sandells handyweights to 257p/kg. A great result on heavy heifers saw lot one from Brian Williams selling to £1,614, with the Dalton stable selling to £1,560 and £1,552.

#### ONLY 38 BULLS FORWARD SOLD TO OV.AV 181P/KG

As previously stated, lots of dairy bred types but strong demand nevertheless.

Cracking shapes from Mark Jones' British Blues selling to 232p/kg, 225p/kg and 223p/kg. Handyweight Blues from Dave Dobbin sold to 216p/kg for 430kg.

A good go on Friesian Holsteins saw Colin Evans selling to 185p/kg on two occasions but with James Woolrich selling his black & whites to 190p/kg at 650kg.

A very respectable entry of hoggs with some Monday markets reporting very small entries, a combination of flooding and snow.

Despite reduced entries, trade similar to last week with customers experiencing severe price resistance, it would appear that the price of lamb may have for the short term maxed out.

An average of 268p/kg with <u>clean</u>, <u>dry</u>, <u>belly clipped</u> hoggs most definitely the order of the day. Best hoggs sold to 301p/kg for 45½kg Texels from Nigel Kinsey and £137 per head. Butchers hoggs were keenly sought after with most 290p/kg to £3/kg. Lighter hoggs sold to 290p/kg for 37½kg from Pete Morris. Once again, 43kg to 44kg hoggs realising the optimum higher prices per kilo are grossing up to the most pounds per head. Hoggs over 50kg were harder work with catering basically closed most sold around £110.

A good entry of hoggs required for next week, but please keep them clean and dry.
