A little after the 'Lord Mayors Show' today with a larger compliment of cattle forward as the weekend rain brought fieldwork to an end for the moment. Once again well finished beasts easily sold but with leaner cattle harder work. A more realistic trade today with some buyers licking their wounds still from last week!

A few steers penned this morning saw a high of 232p/kg with overweight Continentals to £1609 in the lump.

Butchers cattle sold to 268p/kg with heavier females to £1540. Unfortunately not quite the heady heights of last Tuesday's bonanza.

Good bull numbers with nearly three time more than last week. Trade held firm with best Continentals selling to 234p/kg and heavy Limousins past £1600 in the lump. Strong demand on black and whites selling to 190p/kg with little under 170p/kg unless very poor.

<u>6 COWS FORWARD MET A MIXED TRADE</u>.

Well finished farm assured 730kg Limousin cross cows sold to 139p/kg (£1014), with others with belly to 115p/kg for 836kg. Non-assured plain boning cows less money.

Super Limmies steers from John Westwood headed the day here to 232p/kg & 231p/kg for 524kg and 596kg respectively. Handyweight Angus x Lims from Mulberry Homes sold to 230p/kg with 616kg Blues to 229p/kg from Rita Corfield-McCowan. Angus steers sold to 216p/kg from Mrs 'B' with Gordon Jones and James Griffin both selling to 214p/kg. 766kg Limousins from Roger Jordin sold nicely to 210p/kg or £1605 in the lump.

A great run from Curdale Farms once again taking most top calls today selling to 268, 265, 263 and 258p/kg. Handyweight early birds from Mrs 'B' sold to 261p/kg at 488kg , with Richard Parkes usual stamp selling to 260p/kg and Jan Edwards selling at the end of the day to 259p/kg for 496kg. Plenty of demand on handyweight heifers even if they were not the best! 626kg Charolais heifers again from Curdale Farm excelled at £1539.96 in the lump.
