130 PRIME CATTLE

Fewer cattle forward this week with Mark away at the seaside. Deadweight centres again reluctant to support the British farmer when European meat becomes available reducing deadweight prices.

Following an exceptional trade last week, this week's averages looked very similar with U and E grade heifers creating considerable interest.

Another fresh face ringside with bulls to £1454 and 209p/kg, steers to £1230 and 216p/kg and heifers £1310.40 and 253p/kg twice.

Bulls very mixed in quality with very few Continentals on offer and those that were tended to be over 16m and well over 600kg.

12 COWS

12 cows sold to 133p/kg for 648kg Limousin from SJ Raybould, with Holsteins to 98p/kg from Russell Abbiss, with plain Holstein at 74p/kg.

A single stock bull 934kg sold to 145p/kg or £1354.30.

72 CLEAN CATTLE

14 steers sold to av. 178p/kg – Up 5p/kg on last week including several over age animals. Charlie Sandells' 528kg Limousin topped the sale at 216p/kg and 214p/kg, with Phil Roberts breaking to £2/kg barrier at 201p/kg for 612kg Charolais.

58 heifers sold to av. 208p/kg – Richard Parkes and Steve Perkins shared top spot at 253p/kg for Limousins, with several breaking past 240p/kg. Plenty of dairy bred within the average with Simmentals and Charolais x £2/kg to 210p/kg.

46 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 162P/KG

With the overall average back on last week not telling the whole story. Suckler bulls to 209p/kg for 616kg Limousin from Matt Bower and 742kg at 196p/kg, British Blues 634kg to 189p/kg and Holsteins making up almost 80% of the entry selling to 165p/kg, with several over 160p/kg. Heavy Holsteins a sharper trade with an extra customer to last week for heavy, lean bulls.

Normal service will be resumed next week with Mark fully recovered from the jet lag.

Last week's top price bull was mis-reported and was in fact a 532kg bull from M Whitehouse which sold to 220p/kg.
