141 PRIME CATTLE

A few more clean numbers forward saw trade firmer on the best cattle with more commercial sorts difficult. Handy-weight butchers cattle are seeing a roaring trade even though butchers complain about weak shop demand, with producers getting their cattle heavier to try to face the music. With these facts in mind, you may note that a “very deserving cause” sold 458kg heifers just short of £1100 with his 650kg steers struggling below £1200. 200kg more for only £100 more!

A mixed entry of steers with more over-age cattle forward sold to a high of 209p/kg with heavy bullocks to £1275.96 in the lump.

Butchers heifers saw strongest demand selling to 250p/kg with cattle 520kg and below hard to come by. Heavier females sold to £1294.

Bull trade no better, with suckler bred bulls a rarity once again. Shop bulls saw trade similar to butchers heifers to 226p/kg. A mixed trade on Holsteins with plentiful supplies of these and the best to 166p/kg.

17 COWS SOLD TO AV. 90.22P/KG

Cows easiest sold once again but with no best beef cows forward. Fit Herefords sold to 118p/kg for 684kg, with Holstein slips to 109p/kg. Friesian cows sold to 106p/kg for 592kg, with 814kg Friesians to £814 in the lump.

92 CLEAN CATTLE

28 steers sold to av. 173p/kg – Handy-weight headed the pence per kilo stakes with Roger Rowson selling 538kg Blondes reaching 209p/kg, with British Blue crosses to 208p/kg for 530kg for a “very deserving cause”, Well-finished 612kg Limousins to 203p/kg from David Chilton. Blondes from Frank Millichamp sold to £1275.96, with Alistair Beedles’ Limmies to £1270.08. Over 40 month bullocks depressed averages selling below 140p/kg.

64 heifers sold to av. 184p/kg – A super run of five Roger Jordin sold to 250p/kg for 508kg Limmies to steal the limelight. 522kg Limousins from the Chilton stable sold to 245p/kg, with two handy-weight Limousin to 240p/kg from Richard Parkes. 462kg from Charlie Sandells sold to 240p/kg with that “deserving cause” selling to 238p/kg for 458kg.

49 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 156P/KG

Again, a very strong Holstein influence which helped dilute averages. Brian Watkins’ two cracking Blondes sold to 226p/kg and 222p/kg for 520kg and 524kg, with Charolais to 200p/kg for 582kg from Brian Williams. Other Charolais crosses from Dave Preece sold to 194p/kg (£1179.52). 532kg Friesians sold to 166p/kg from Colin Evans, with 548kg Friesians from Julian Aston to 156p/kg

Clean, indoor hogs topped the sale at 209p/kg for 40kg Texels from Ray Bason, with plenty of 40kg to 42.5kg hogs over £2/kg. Heavier hogs still sought after to 205p/kg for 50kg from Peter Levi, 52kg to 201p/kg from James Woolrich and a top price per head of £106.95.

Texel ewes topped the sale at £125, Texel x ewes at £98.50, Suffolks £94, with North Country Mules showing the most improvement to £83.

Leaner ewes still look dear against over-fat ewes. Leaner Suffolks to £81.50 and Mules £74.

Scotch Blackface to £63, Welsh £56 and lean Cheviots £44.50. 23 rams to £123 Texel, lean Texels £95 and Welsh Mountain £78.
