157 PRIME CATTLE

Similar numbers forward, saw all clean cattle meet a firm trade but bulls seeing a more difficult market. Our overall average was 3p/kg down on last Tuesday but included more over thirty month cattle and Holstein bred types.

A decent number of bullocks, with best sorts selling to 207p/kg or £1318 in the lump. Plenty of demand for butchers cattle saw Heifers selling to 232p/kg or £1328 as a body. More commercial breaking cattle saw a decent level of demand unless very fat.

Holsteins were well represented in the bull section along with a sprinkling of suckler bred sorts. Continentals sold to 200p/kg or £1189 in the lump.

16 COWS SOLD TO AV. 100P/KG

A reasonable number with more milking cows forward.

800kg Limousin sucklers sold to 138p/kg, with meat Holsteins 722kg to 124p/kg, Red Herefords to 110p/kg on two occasions, Plain cows from 69-92p/kg depending on bag and belly.

110 CLEAN CATTLE

36 Steers sold to average 165p/kg, 528 & 502kg Limousins from Ray Bason sold to 207 & 205p/kg and 640kg Blondes sold to 206p/kg from Neale Dalton. 486kg Limousins to 203p/kg from Frank Millichamp. Friesians sold to 140p/kg OTM from Mr Boden.

74 Heifers sold to average 186p/kg. Richard Morgan topped the day at 232p/kg for 484kg Limousin. 565kg from Neale Dalton sold to 230p/kg, with 504kg Limousins to 225p/kg from Ray Bason. 474kg handy Limousin from Jean Kirkham sold to 228p/kg with another to 223p/kg from the same stable. 522kg Limousins also hit 223p/kg from Roger Jordin. Holstein Heifers to 135p/kg from Julian Aston.

Lambs sold to an easier trade following the national trend, however, Bridgnorth's overall average would compare very favourably with other auctions this week.

Overall quality perhaps not quite as good as last week with fewer heavy weights which were keenly sought after. 46kg sold to £2 with 44.5kg at 217p/kg to a top price per head of £96.60.

Handier weights to 228p/kg for 37.5kg from Dave Sturgess with tight skinned 'fresh' lambs selling to a premium.

Lighter and leaner lambs although less per kilo were probably no less per pound dead, selling to 208p/kg for 34kg and 204p/kg for 29.5kg.
