A small Bank Holiday week entry saw cattle a firm trade especially is they ticked all the boxes. All cattle sold in line or above deadweight quotations, with large abattoirs ringing around this morning short of cattle. An overall average just short of 190p/kg was seriously depleted by a strong Holstein influence in the bulls.

Less than double figures of steers sold to 205p/kg or £1460 in the lump. More steers could have easily sold especially 550kg-700kg with meat.

Heifers were a sharp trade to 249p/kg on two occasions with many 240p/kg or above. Heavy females to £1345.

More bulls than clean helped fill regular orders and saw prices in front of last week. Heavy Continental bulls with shape sold to 216p/kg or £1568 in the whole. Meated black and white bulls were a cracking trade to 176p/kg.

Farm Assured small Jersey cows 438kg sold to 57p/kg from John Eveson. 604kg ruby Devon cows sold to 92p/kg for Mr Colley with plenty of bark on.

Only 8 steers sold to av. 182p/kg – The Truswell brothers' 712kg Charolais headed the section at 205p/kg with their 544kg British Blue to 200p/kg. Holstein steers to 159p/kg.

49 heifers sold to av. 217p/kg – The normal run of quality from Richard Parkes sold to 249p/kg to average 242p/kg on seven Limousins. IGC Morris' Blonde equalled this at 249p/kg for 516kg. Sweet 466kg Limmies from Charlie Sandells sold to 248p/kg, with Dave Chilton selling to 246p/kg and 240p/kg. Heavier Limousins to £1345 from David Bradley.
