In fact the heavier lambs dearest to £131 for 59kg from Suffolk lambs from JJ Johnstone Farms. Texel lambs weighing 59kg to £127, Charollais £124.60 and Beltex £117.30.

A top price per kilo of 267 for the second week running from Pete Morris for 38.5kg Beltex' and a super run of lambs from George Evans to 265p/kg, averaging 44kg at 246p/kg and £109.10.
