More bulls forward but less clean saw trade no faster. Best butchers cattle was a little harder to sell but with breaking cattle a firm trade unless they were too lean for the trade. They were best suited to the store market.

A sprinkling of steers forward saw the best Continental selling to 214p/kg or £1339-64 in the lump. Butchers heifers sold to 250p/kg with many others in the 230p/kg - 240 p/kg and adding up in front of heavier breaking types.

Bull trade was steady throughout with more heavier Continentals penned this morning. Few handy weight shop bulls sold to 198p/kg with heavy Continental to just short of £1400. Meaty Friesian Holsteins met consistent values to 165p/kg on two occasions.

4 Cull cows sold to a high of 135p/kg for Blondes from Brian Watkins at 832kg closely followed by a British Blue to 184p/kg from Chris and Gordon Jones. More buyers for cows today.
