Tight for numbers once again and a tremendous trade from start to finish. No let up in prices as buyers competed for cattle with more needed to satisfy demand. Plenty of cattle exceeding £2000 per head with well finished sorts selling to a premium.

Only a handful of steers which were quite often dairy bred, sold to a top of 340p/kg or £2106 in the lump.

A nice show of heifers saw a high of 366p/kg with a top price per head of £2239.

Only one cull cow saw a British Blue cross selling to 188p/kg for 730kg (£1372.40).

Less bulls met a sharp trade to a high of 314p/kg with fewer heavier bulls and a top price per head of £2178.

8 STEERS SOLD TO OV AV 283P/KG

It was great to see Keith Tolley back again topping this department with his shapey Blues selling to 340p/kg for 602kg. Clare Burgoyne sold her Limousin to 300p/kg for 702kg (£2106) with her Angus to 291p/kg for 648kg.

42 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV AV 310P/KG

Lots one and two from Harvey Parkes were quick off the mark selling to 365p/kg and 366p/kg for 506kg and 524kg respectively with another to 359p/kg from the same port. A great run of five from Evans, Curdale all exceeded £2000 average to a high of 360p/kg or £2073.60. Roger Jordin's normal quality topped at 358p/kg for 546kg Limmie. Heavies from Edward Howells stacked up well at £2238.80 for 772kg (290p/kg).

ONLY 11 BULLS SOLD TO OV AV 270P/KG

A cracking Limousin from Howard Fish shone realising 314p/kg for 554kg with a run of four from Paul Taylor topping at 305p/kg for 714kg (£2177.70). Did anyone see a smile? Dave Preece's single Limousin sold to 297p/kg taking third spot. Overage and lean types included in the average.


