Depleted numbers of clean cattle saw a very sharp trade, with butchers needing more cattle to fulfil orders. Best quality handy-weight cattle saw the greatest lift at 5-6p/kg in places, with more commercial cattle in front of static dead-weight quotations for the week.

A small sample of steers with some nice sorts sold to a high of 227p/kg, with heavier bullocks to £1459.48.

Butchers heifers sold to 250p/kg with a firm trade on only wellfinished females. Farm Assurance is becoming more of an issue even in this department.

Bull trade easily held values with a very varied sample forward and best types thin on the ground. Continentals sold to 206p/kg for Limousins, with Herefords to 199p/kg. Holsteins were lacking shape and finish generally, with the best to 170p/kg.

ONLY 4 COWS FORWARD saw trade similar to last week with ordinary but fed Limousin cross cows selling to 114p/kg, with Friesians to 107p/kg for decent steaking types.

Only 9 steers sold to average 190p/kg – A cracking 514kg Limmie from Peter Gore took to honours at 227p/kg, with heavier Limousins to 222p/kg for a "very deserving cause" for 552kg and 656kg. Blue Limousins sold to £1459.48 for 682kg for the same "needy cause". Over-age cattle would have benefitted from Farm Assurance on this occasion.

50 heifers sold to av. 211p/kg – Richard Parkes' Limmie stars sold passed 240p/kg on four occasions to 250p/kg for 488kg Limousins. British Blue from Dave Chilton took second spot at 249p/kg for 472kg. 504kg Limousins from Phil Clarke sold to 232p/kg. Heavier females sold to £1434.44 for 658kg from Brian & Wallace Jones.
