81 PRIME CATTLE

Auctioneer – Mark Burgoyne 07831 192603

A much more varied sample of beasts penned this morning, with meat and finish definitely in shorter supply. There were more bellied cattle today, especially in the bulls where producers were selling cattle to reduce feed bills on the face of it.

More steers forward saw best shapes selling to 291p/kg, with £1878 top price per head.

Butcher's heifers topped at 320p/kg, with 6 females 300p/kg or above. Few heavy females forward sold to £1728 and £1674.

Our bull sample was mixed giving the auctioneer a tricky task to hold prices there! Continentals topped at 255p/kg with others to 253p/kg. Heavy bulls sold to £1932 for 814kg. Amazingly, no Friesian/Holstein bulls forward at all.

45 CLEAN CATTLE

19 STEERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 243P/KG

A cracking Limousin from Evans Curdale topped here at 632kg, making 291p/kg (£1839.12), closely followed by Roger Jordin selling his slightly heavier Limmie to 288p/kg (£1877.76). Shapey, handy steers sold to 280p/kg at 490kg. from John Cantrill. Limmies of 570kg sold to 260p/kg from Bill Rodenhurst with young Blues to the same from 'Mrs B'.

26 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 272P/KG

Three of the best Limmies from Evans Curdale started here at 320p/kg, 316p/kg and 310p/kg. Richard Parkes and Roger Jordin sold the best of their run to 309p/kg and 302p/kg respectively. Curdale's 320p/kg heifer also was top price per head at £1728.

36 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 219P/KG

More numbers but less quality was the auctioneer's observation today.

Dan Watkins was top dog here with his Limmie selling to 255p/kg for 608kg. Second spot went to Richard Povall selling one of a pair to 253p/kg for 596kg. Rob Thomas sold his Angus x Salers to 249p/kg at 564kg, with Paul Taylor selling 634kg Limmies to 246p/kg.

Heavy Charolais sold to £1937.32 for 814kg at 14 months from Charlie Cadwallader.

An average of 230p/kg up around 15p/kg on last week although the general quality would be better.

Best lambs a very firm trade to 288p/kg at 44kg for Beltex from Pete Morris and several pens sold to 260p/kg plus.

Heavy weights remain keenly sought after with Neil Ellis selling his Texels for £154 and Josh Munday's 54.5kg lambs at 238p/kg.

Lambs under 37kg showed considerable improvement to 237p/kg from Richard Parkes and more hill bred sheep generally over 215p/kg with only the pure Welsh under 200p/kg.

With the onset of winter, please be mindful that clean, dry lambs will start to sell to a premium.

A similar entry of ewes to last week with quality ewes short in number but well sought after. Texel cross ewes sold to £159, Suffolk x Mules ewes sold to £134 and a whole alleyway of North Country Mules, lacking size and power, sold to £110.

Large numbers of plainer mules the worst at £40, with warmed up Mules £55 plus.

As recent weeks Continental ewes most sought after with better sorts £130 to £159 and plainer, smaller sheep £120.

Most breeds of hill ewes were represented with Cheviot ewes selling to a premium to £87 for medium sorts and £60 for the plain. Small-meated Scotch ewes sold to £42 with Welsh £38 and small, plain hill ewes a similar trade to last week.

Rams sold to £160 from Pete Kirton and yearling wethers £100.
