Another Christmas Show supported by a good entry of show lambs with 47 pens in 4 classes judged by Mark Perrins of Farmers Fresh.

Peter Morris took top honours, The Brian Meredith Cup, for the best single lamb with his 50kg Beltex realising 228p/kg and purchased by M & S Butchers, Bridgnorth. Peter also took the George King Cup for the overall champion pen of lambs for his 44kg Beltex also purchased by M & S Butchers, Bridgnorth and finally cleaning up with the Reserve Champion pen with his 40.5kg lambs realising 242p/kg and purchased by Pak Meats.

Trade gained momentum throughout, with the show pens of lambs a firmer trade than singles this year. This said, single lambs generally over 50kg with lighter weights £2/kg and over. Trade continued throughout the commercials averaging 173.5p/kg to 183p/kg and generally up around 5p/kg on last week.

Heavy weights 52.5kg to 183p/kg show, and 170p/kg commercials from Richard Morgan.
