141 PRIME CATTLE

With numbers of cattle down on last week, trade was no better, although there were less lean handy-weight cattle forward, especially heifers. Heavy, more commercial sorts again proved more difficult to sell, with a ring full of buyers not looking to purchase excess numbers.

A sprinkling of good steers met a satisfactory trade, with best bullocks to 220p/kg or £1364 in the lump. Holstein steers sold to 149p/kg.

Fewer handy-weight heifers saw the cream to 251p/kg, with heavier, thicker cattle harder to sell. Heavy females to £1310.

Bull trade was generally good with more customers around the ring and more were required to fulfil orders. Best handy-weight suckler bulls sold to 224p/kg on two occasions, with heavies to £1309.44. Black and white bulls to 159p/kg.

ONLY 15 COWS SOLD TO AV. 102.3P/KG

Cows were easier to sell than the ordinary clean with non-assured young sucklers to 146p/kg for 726kg Limousins. 658kg steaking Holsteins to 107p/kg. Four buyers for cows and more were needed.

99 CLEAN CATTLE

24 steers sold to av. 175p/kg – Blondes from Rob Lilley headed this section to 220p/kg for 620kg (£1364), with handy weights from Peter Gore to 215p/kg for 538kg Limmies. LH Wardle sold Limousins to 209p/kg with Alastair Beedles selling to 200p/kg for 630kg.

75 heifers sold to av. 187p/kg – Neil Perkins went back home to a lamb a ewe and in his absence topped the market at 251p/kg for 492kg. A Charolais from long-time absentee Derek Tomley sold to 249p/kg, with Richard Parkes selling to 238p/kg. 518kg Blondes from Rob Lilley sold to 234p/kg, with 542kg Lims to 237p/kg from IGC Morris.

42 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 171P/KG

Too few bulls for awaiting customers with 544kg Lims from Todd Harris selling to 224p/kg, with 522kg Limousins from Ian Morris achieving the same. 594kg Blondes sold to 216p/kg from Brian Watkins.

Friesians sold to 159p/kg from Robin Maydew and Rita Corfield, with Dave Preece selling to 156p/kg.

This week's average of 185p/kg standing on from last week seemed generally pleasing to a top price of 208p/kg from Richard Morgan and even though heavier hoggs were a little easier than last week, a top price of £99.40 for 55.5kg Suffolk lambs from Robert Lilley.

Overall quality of hoggs this year has been quite mixed, a reflection on the very wet weather. When marketing hoggs please present them in a clean condition as dirty sheep can be a problem.
