106 PRIME CATTLE

Disappointing numbers forward considering last week's trade but perhaps the reality is that numbers are very tight. Buyers struggled to fill viable loads and a great trade resulted, with some fantastic cattle penned this morning – a real credit to our producers!

There were some tremendous steers forward today, which sold to 262p/kg with heavy bullocks selling to £1482.12.

Short of females today and the best butcher's types sold to 295p/kg. Heavy females met firm demand selling to a most respectable £1734 in the lump with two others past £1600.

Bull trade started the day off well but with some pretty ordinary sorts forward in a place or two. Best suckler types sold to 240p/kg and £1427 in the lump. Black and white bulls a storming trade to 208p/kg. Tail-end Charlies would help to deplete the overall average dramatically.

3 cows forward with more required with a fresh face around the ring. Heavy meated Holsteins sold to 127p/kg for 826kg. Overall average 94p/kg.

ONLY 9 STEERS SOLD TO OV.AV. 218P/KG

Handyweight butchers Limmies sold to 262p/kg from Andrew Bishop, closely followed by Nigel Fieldhouse whose Limousin sold to 256p/kg. A 716kg Limousin from Chris Jones added up to £1482.12 with Blondes to £1435.20 from Frank Millichamp.

65 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 227P/KG

Andrew Bishop was top dog here also with his 456kg Limousin selling to 295p/kg. Evans (Curdale) run of 5 sold to a top of 289p/kg with Mrs 'B' selling to 269p/kg and 266p/kg. A great run of quality from Richard Parkes saw three Limmies achieve 267p/kg. Rob and Pete Hartley's run of homebred British Blues sold to 266p/kg for 494kg. A 764kg Limousin from Edward Howells added up nicely at £1734.28 with Evans (Curdale) selling to £1643.52 for 642kg and Mark Jones to £1622.40 for 676kg.

32 BULLS SOLD TO OV.AV. 186P/KG

Homebred Limmies from Bill Yeomans topped here at 240p/kg for 570kg, with another to 229p/kg for 572kg. A 626kg British Blue took third spot from the Hartley's at 228p/kg. Blues from Colin Evans sold to 221p/kg for 562kg.

A similar trade on Holstein Friesians but with some extremely plain bulls about. Steve Howells sold Friesians to 208p/kg for 550kg, with another to 196p/kg from the same home.

Possibly one of the better trades to date averaging 288p/kg to 332p/kg and heavy lamb's way over £150 to £167.

Top price this week of 332p/kg for Beltex from Tim Kyte with clean belly clipped hogs, with finish and shape attracting considerable interest, plenty 315p/kg to 325p/kg.

More commercial hogs generally either side of £3/kg, with heavier weights showing considerable improvement 56kg at 298p/kg from Richard Morgan, Richard Yates 56kg at 271p/kg and Suffolk x Mules from Dave Bradley 262p/kg.

Lighter hogs to 290p/kg for 35.5kg Cheviots from Roger Burgoyne and Hill breeds less per kilo but possible dearer hung up, 32kg at 267p/kg.
