Fewer cattle forward but still a decent entry. Plenty of well-fleshed cattle about, as cattle have been yarded for some time at this point. Best quality heifers no dearer but with commercial types seeing plenty of demand if well-finished.

Some tidy steers penned, with several over 700kg. Continentals saw a firm trade (above dead quotes for this week generally) selling to £1437.48 in the lump of 217p/kg.

Butchers beasts no more money, with steers selling to 251p/kg, with six others above 240p/kg. Heavy females to £1368.

Bull trade held up well all through, with best Continentals selling to 215p/kg, with heavy Charolais to £1447. Some well-finished black and whites penned this morning sold well to £1477 in the lump and 175p/kg.

# **80 CLEAN CATTLE**

18 Steers sold to ov.av.189p/kg — A super run of Limmies from John Johnston sold to 217p/kg on two occasions, with another to 214p/kg. Dave Whiteman's Limousin sold to 200p/kg for 630kg, with Frank Millichamp's Blondes to £1437.48 for 726kg. 62 Heifers sold to ov.av. 209p/kg — Top headlines from Clive Evans sold to 251p/kg, 245p/kg and 241p/kg, all red Limousins up to 538kg, with Richard Parkes taking second spot to 247p/kg for 498kg. 508kg Limousin crosses sold to 244p/kg at 11 months for a "very deserving cause". Once again, Frank Millichamp took top pounds per head at £1368.40 for 622kg Blondes.

Shapey Blondes from Brian Watkins excelled at 215p/kg, 213p/kg and 211p/kg for 630kg, 308kg and 624kg respectively. Young Limmies at 576kg sold to 213p/kg from the Sandells family.
