A larger than expected post-Bank Holiday entry saw trade firming- especially on the middle of the road breaking sorts, with the best cattle maintaining values from start to finish. Although the average is good, we did have our fair share of small shapeless sorts but all of these found new homes at satisfactory values.

Best steers sold well to 234p/kg or £1342 in the lump, with a strong Holstein influence along with some “late cut” Continentals on the lean-side.

Plenty of go in the butchers heifer trade sold to a market high of 246p/kg with several 240p/kg or above. As previously stated thick meated commercial cattle in strong demand with native breeds in particular to the fore.

Bull numbers were particularly pleasing with best Continentals no dearer to 215p/kg. Holsteins easiest sold once again to 172p/kg. More bull buyers anticipated next week.

ONLY 3 COWS sold to a very dear trade to 167p/kg for 656kg Limousins (£1095.52). Foreign eartags sold to 110p/kg for 816kg black and whites, with plain cows to 102p/kg.

74 heifers sold to av. 202p/kg – A super run from Richard Parkes stole the honours at 246p/kg, with Roger Jordin selling his run of five to 244p/kg. Stuart Bebb sold 542kg to 242p/kg, with Limousins 486kg to 240p/kg. Neale Dalton sold to £1312.64 for 586kg. Welsh Whites sold to 227p/kg for 462kg from Dan Williams. Two Hereford crosses from Dave Chilton to 191p/kg.
