167 PRIME CATTLE

A sharp trade once again with values holding up well. More commercial types forward today alongside our normal contingent of top quality sorts. One buyer down today but set to return next week, with their trade affected by cows being marketed more quickly due to the drought conditions which are prevailing over the south of England and the midlands. Fingers crossed for rain soon!! The big buyers were short!

Our steer entry was mixed with not too many top notches here. Top shout was 226p/kg or £1487.08 in the lump. Better demand on Holsteins and dairy-bred sorts.

250p/kg was achieved on three occasions with numerous butchers' heifers in the 240pences. Heavier females sold well to £1424.64.

Bull trade continued the momentum from last week with best continentals to 216p/kg. Heavy sucklers sold to £1399 in the lump. Black and white trade was good for the sorts available selling to 170p/kg.

7 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL

Once again the 'old girls' were in demand and our advice is to sell on this trade for reasons previously stated. Continental cows sold to 138p/kg + 134p/kg. Friesian cows with some meat sold to 115p/kg. Lean but young stock bulls sold well to 157p/kg for 854kg (£1340.87).

21 STEERS SOLD TO OV.AV. 171P/KG

Non assured Limmies from James Griffin topped this section at 226p/kg for 658kg (£1487.08) with Paul Taylor in second spot at 218p/kg for his 638kg Limousin. John Westwood and John Cantrill both sold their steers to 192p/kg.

90 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 206P/KG

A tremendous entry of heifers again saw Simon Jones, Richard Fenton and Richard Parkes all sell to the top price of 250p/kg. Other prices of note were the Parkes' family 249p/kg (x2), Richard Fenton 248p/kg, Matt Bower 246p/kg and Simon Jones 246p/kg. Heavy heifers from Ted Rogers sold to £1424.64 for 636kg Charolais, with 602kg Limmies to £1336.44 from John Westwood.

A very successful day with deadweight prices easing once again and not for the first time this season, the livestock markets set the trade for other to follow. Time and time again we see negative pressure reversed and trade made with the live market.

Heavier lambs followed on from last week with 43kg plus lambs to 281p/kg – RC Evans and 50kg lambs at £116.

Butchers lambs 36kg to 42kg around £120 for the best from Luke Price, Evans Curdale and Andrew Preece. The easiest weights to sell would be lambs under 40kg, pen after pen 260p/kg to 290p/kg.

Only 8 rams selling to £96 for Texels from Dave Halford and Gordon Jones

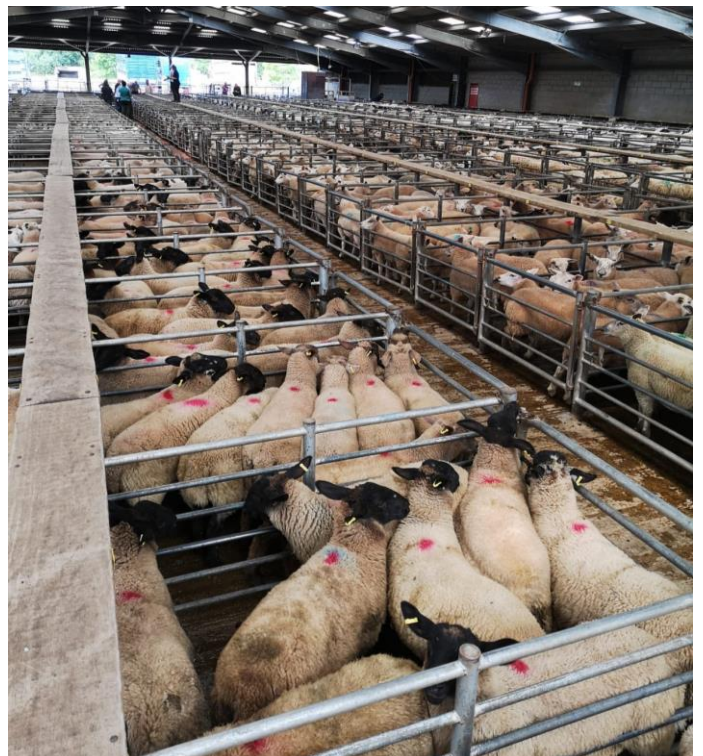

WASH OUT CHARGES

Please note that the £4 charge deducted from producer's cheques does not mean we are charging customers for a service we are not able to provide at the moment due to Covid-19 Regulations. This charge has been deducted ever since the licencing regulations that were introduced since the Foot and Mouth outbreak in 2001-2002.

This involves increased washing of our penning and ring area, increased disinfection usage, increased veterinary inspections, increased charges emptying water into the main sewer etc etc.

We have attempted to keep our charges down and this is a flat rate fee and has only increase £1 during the last 19 years.

Unfortunately our computer system does not allow us alter the coding of this charge, so please understand that this is far more cost effective for producers than an increase in our commission rate which we are attempting to keep at a very competitive level.

We hope the washing of your trailers can resume in the near future. Until such time only livestock hauliers and market staff are able to use the lorry wash.

Your patience and support is much appreciated during these unprecedented times.
