### 100 PRIME CATTLE

Less cattle forward as a consequence of the better weather but more likely as a result of the easier trade experienced recently throughout the meat industry, with abattoirs reporting very reduced throughputs. However, the smaller entry helped trade and against all the trends, trade throughout the cattle section would be stronger, with steers up 10p/kg, heifers to 248p/kg with ten over 240p/kg and bulls just shy of £1500.

Cows to £1000 and 148p/kg for Limousin from Harold Pugh.

### CLEAN CATTLE

**Steers sold to ov.av.193p/kg** – Steers to 219p/kg for 618kg from Gordon Jones and 606kg to 214p/kg from JB Morris, with Frank Davenport's Limmo to £1425. Over-age steers to £1200 for 772kg, with trade generally sharp for all weights and grades regardless of FABBL status.

**Heifers sold to ov.av.209p/kg** – Heifers to 248p/kg for the usual sample from Richard Parkes however, trade held throughout his run of Limousin heifers averaging 500kg and 242p/kg. A very nice pair from Steve Perkins 492kg and 496kg sold for 245p/kg and 246p/kg.

Heavy heifers from Dave Preece to £1440 and Frank Davenport at £1414.

This week, not only plenty of interest in all those best cattle but the lesser dairy bred showing improvement.

### BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 162P/KG

Less bulls this week to 206p/kg for 542kg Limousin from Bill Yeoman, with almost all bulls forward being dairy breeds to 159p/kg for 594kg Holsteins from Harold Pugh.

Charlie Cadwallader's Charollais bulls to £1491 and £1414 closely followed by Gordon Kennerley's South Devons to £1400.

What we has in quantity, we lacked in quality with a large percentage of leaner lambs forward which on a falling trade made the job of selling harder.

An average of 190p/kg would be very diluted with the better lambs up to 229p/kg for 45kg from Peter Johnson. Heavier weights generally easier to sell, the best of which realised over £100 to £104 from Peter Levi.

40kg Texels from George Evans to 225p/kg and lighter lambs proving harder work; a reflection on the finish on the lambs to 201p/kg for 33.5kg.
