However, the smaller entry helped trade and against all the trends, trade throughout the cattle section would be stronger, with steers up 10p/kg, heifers to 248p/kg with ten over 240p/kg and bulls just shy of £1500.

CLEAN CATTLE

Steers sold to ov.av.193p/kg – Steers to 219p/kg for 618kg from Gordon Jones and 606kg to 214p/kg from JB Morris, with Frank Davenport's Limmo to £1425. Over-age steers to £1200 for 772kg, with trade generally sharp for all weights and grades regardless of FABBL status.

Heifers sold to ov.av.209p/kg – Heifers to 248p/kg for the usual sample from Richard Parkes however, trade held throughout his run of Limousin heifers averaging 500kg and 242p/kg. A very nice pair from Steve Perkins 492kg and 496kg sold for 245p/kg and 246p/kg.

Heavy heifers from Dave Preece to £1440 and Frank Davenport at £1414.

This week, not only plenty of interest in all those best cattle but the lesser dairy bred showing improvement.
