Short of cattle once again although better than last week by some way. Trade a touch firmer, with heifers and steers – including several commercial sorts - averaging above 280p/kg all through and bull trade firm, with plenty of weight and meat the order of the day.

Steers sold past 300p/kg to a high of 306p/kg for handy weights and heavier steers to £1890 in the lump.

Heifers saw a sharp trade to a high of 342p/kg with heavier females to £1900.

Some very useful bulls forward saw a high of 295p/kg with four bulls past £2000 to a top of £2344!

From last Tuesday the national lamb trade has slipped every day with some auctions reporting trade sub 300p/kg, so an average of 307p/kg achieved in Bridgnorth would be less than recent sales but compares very favourably with other auctions and deadweight centres.

Better lambs remain keenly sought after with customers more than happy to pay for quality but keen to avoid lean lambs. A top price this week of 340p/kg achieved twice for 44kg and 43kg lambs from David Talbot and Graham Davies.

The heavy lambs most sought after with 49.5kg from Andrew Preece at 335p/kg and £179.30 for 54kg lambs from Tony Davies.

Lambs under 40kg to 320p/kg for 36.5kg from Mark Steele although it had to be a good lamb to be over the 300p/kg barrier.
