A handful more cattle penned this morning, with a very good show of quality sorts, alongside a large run of useful commercial types. Trade is holding its own at the moment, as deadweight centres continue to pull prices back, perhaps 2-3p/kg each week.

Some good steers forward sold to a firm trade to a top of 293p/kg or £1840 in the lump.

Heifers passed the magic 300p/kg barrier on three occasions to a high of 305p/kg, with some quality heavier females to £1793 in the lump.

Bulls saw an easier trade, with best sucklers on the leaner side to 256p/kg on two occasions. Black and white bulls did not exceed 200p/kg.
