131 PRIME CATTLE

We require more cattle to meet present need, with the live market seeing a dramatic upturn in trade. Best quality sorts saw strong demand but with all shapes and sizes seeing an upward price even if too fat. The overall market average of 183p/kg reflected this especially when you consider the mix of types penned this morning.

There were hardly any suckler bred steers forward today with the best selling to 227p/kg, with OTM steers to £1420.

Butchers heifers met a fiery trade selling to 242p/kg, with more over 230p/kg than recent sales. Second string heifers seldom below 200p/kg unless totally without shape. Heavy heifers to £1444 in the lump.

There were some awkward bulls forward with weight, age and plain sorts plentiful. Handy weight sucklers sold to 210p/kg. Friesian bulls sold to 176p/kg on two occasions.

22 COWS SOLD TO AV. 102P/KG

A better number of cows forward but with quality lacking. Once again, there were several leaner boners forward.

Charolais crosses sold to 140p/kg for 588kg from Gerald Lewis. 496kg slip Simmentals sold to 135p/kg from S Pennington. Friesian cows to 117p/kg for Henry Yates and Mr Boden.

88 CLEAN CATTLE

25 steers sold to an overall average of 171p/kg. 227p/kg was top dollar here for Dave Chilton's Limousin 616kg. A 30m Limousin from Shropshire & Jones sold to 207p/kg to add up to £1420. A decent run of Angus crosses from Phillip Terry was headed by a 672kg steer at 198p/kg. Dave Preece's well finished Friesians soared at 184p/kg for 662kg.

Only 63 heifers sold to average 205p/kg. A run of four from Roger Jordin sold to 242p/kg, 239p/kg and 230p/kg – the last one 628kg (£1444). 550kg Limousins from Matt & Wendy Bower sold to 240p/kg. Dave Chilton's tucked up heifer achieved 239p/kg, closely followed by Neil Perkins and Dan Williams.

43 YOUNG BULLS OV. AV. 162P/KG

Bulls were a sharper trade today with well finished cattle in strongest demand. Shop bulls from Brian Watkins sold to 210p/kg for 512kg Blondes, with 594kg black Limousin to 196p/kg for Steve Perkins. 590kg Limousins to 192p/kg from Graham Barker. Hereford crosses sold to 179p/kg from Graham Johnson, with Friesians to 176p/kg for Charlie Lloyd and David Evans.

Several new customers were in attendance for the first time and swelled the crowd of regular supporters travelling from Devon and surrounding counties.

The overall average was very respectable although £1 per head back on last year with wether lambs back and ewe lambs up on last year

3,300 wether lambs sold to £66.20 Suffolk x Mules and £66.20 Texel x Mules with very few of the smaller long term lambs under £53.

2,000 ewe lambs to £93 Suffolk x Mules, £88 Texel x Mules and £80 New Zealand Suffolk x Mules, with running lambs well over £60 with a large number £65 to £68.
