A very successful show and sale with all classes keenly contested. A firmer trade for both show and commercial lambs with the quality prize winners selling to a premium.

This year's judge was Mike Pearce of M & S Butchers, Bridgnorth who awarded the George King Cup for the overall Champion Pen to Peter Morris for his 37kg Beltex lambs realised 460p/kg and £170, purchased by Arthur Tilley.

The Brian Meredith Cup for the best single lamb also went to Peter Morris at 49kg and sold to 242p/kg and was purchased by the judge, Mike Pearce.

Peter Morris took a clean sweep with three first prizes, Champion. Ed Bunning received Reserve Champion for his 35kg Beltex purchased by M & S Butchers.

First prize in the Smallholders class went to Jackie Lewis with 42.5kg selling to 224p/kg to Nigel Coles, Rugeley.

Trade throughout the show was very brisk with several pens of non-prize winning lambs well over £2/kg notably 43kg at 232p/kg, 39kg at 228p/kg, 36.5kg at 222p/kg and 40kg at 222p/kg.

Commercial lambs up around 3-5p/kg on last week to 191p/kg for a super run of Charollais lambs from Ashley Robinson 44kg to 48kg. Lighter weights to 175p/kg for 34kg, with the majority of sheep on offer over 44kg which sold around £90.
