105 PRIME CATTLE

With buyers, abattoirs and farmers looking to get started follow the Christmas holiday break, we had a very good entry penned this morning and a sharp trade from start to finish. Trade was aided by all the cattle being well finished and full of meat, which was a real credit to the producers. Both bulls and clean cattle entries sold to an advantage, with a handful of cows seeing a large step forward in value.

A good show of steers saw a top of 296p/kg with heavier bullocks adding up to £1813 in the lump.

Butchers' heifers excelled with 16 selling on or beyond the 300p/kg figure to a top of 328p/kg. Heavy females sold just sort of £1900 in the body.

Four bidders on the bulls with few best sorts forwards. Continentals, sold to 261p/kg with black and whites seeing a strong trade to 217p/kg.

3 cows sold to an exceptional trade to a high of 210p/kg for 766kg Blues or £1608 in the lump, with other British Blue crosses to 170p/kg and 158p/kg with less shape and more belly.

86 CLEAN CATTLE

23 STEERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 259P/KG

560kg Limousins from Mrs B topped here at 296p/kg with similar weights to 288p/kg from Will Rodenhurst. Handy weights from John Cantrill & family sold to 273p/kg for 514kg. Blondes to £1812.72 for 664kg from Millichamp Bros. Shorthorns to 270p/kg and British Whites to 256p/kg, all from that 'deserving cause'. Angus crosses to 261p/kg from the Rodenhurst stable once again.

63 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 273P/KG

A great show of meaty heifers sold to a stunning 328p/kg from Harvey Parkes who sold other handyish Limmies to 322p/kg and 318p/kg. It was great to see Nigel Fieldhouse back selling 540kg Limousin to 317p/kg equalled by Evans Curdale with their 550kg Limousin. 694kg Limousins from Chris Jones added up well at £1894.62, with 628kg Limmies to £1884 from Evans Curdale. Other prices of note over that 300p/kg were achieved by Rob Pugh and Roger Jordin.

19 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 222P/KG

Richard Prices best Limmie stole the honours at 261p/kg for 608kg. Limmies from James Woolrich sold to 248p/kg

With Simmental crosses to 247p/kg from Bill Yeomans.

Black & White bulls were a sharp trade to 217p/kg for 546kg from Roger Rowson. Holsteins above 500kg at a marked advantage.

A very different trade to last week's exceptional trade averaging 240p/kg.

Best butcher's lambs short in supply but high street butchers reluctant to over-commit to too much lamb, sales slowing down after the pre-Christmas rush.

Rob Jones took top place with his Texel lambs 43kg at 296p/kg and heavier Texel lambs from Stuart Moss 61kg at £150. Trade generally much harder work with a typical January feel.

Lighter lambs 39kg to 255p/kg from Mr & Mrs Rushbrooke and more hill bred lambs from 36kg to 254p/kg.

With darker mornings lambs are getting later and later coming to market, please try to arrive at worst before the start time of 10.00 am.
