A very pleasing number of clean cattle forward and a similar number of bulls made for a busy market with trade easily holding its own compared to last week. All cattle sold to average 188p/kg, with the general quality of the yard full of cattle not quite as good as recent sales.

The steer trade was good and did not reflect the money taken out by the major abattoirs Monday morning. Bazadaise bullocks sold to 215p/kg with heavier sorts to £1427.00 at 34 months. Butchers heifers were more difficult to find if you wanted the best. Top price was 243p/kg. There were more commercial breaking sorts forward.

Probably a better sample of bulls but more were required to satisfy orders. Best suckler bulls sold to 230p/kg at 22 months with Friesians to 175p/kg. Heavy bulls to £1578.

14 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL

A small entry of cows with several ultra-plain sorts forward. Best Limousin 868kg cows sold to 145p/kg for LH Wardle, with Charolais to 130p/kg for Brian Williams. 786kg Friesians sold to 112p/kg from Henry Yates. Boners 50-60p/kg. 900kg Saler stock bulls to 112p/kg from Jim Thomas.
