PRIME CATTLE (RED)

178 PRIME CATTLE

A very good entry of clean cattle penned this morning but with bull numbers difficult to maintain. With the larger dead-weight centres reducing prices by 5-10p/kg for Monday morning, we had a fair trade in comparison, with the live auction holding prices up pretty well although retail demand seems slow. We had plenty of buyers for the cattle with competitive bidding from start to finish to produce an overall average of 191.2p/kg including over thirty month and non-assured cattle not discounted.

There were some better quality steers about today selling to 225p/kg on two occasions and to £1449 in the lump.

More butchers heifers about helped fulfil regular orders, with best retail cattle to 250p/kg, with heavy females to £1444.40.

Bull trade held up well with some better sorts forward. Heavy Continentals sold to 217p/kg with heavies over 16 months selling to £1519.56 in the lump. Friesians sold to 181p/kg.

28 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL

A fantastic trade but there were no best meated suckler types forward. Friesian Holsteins sold to 137p/kg for 628kg from Culloden House Farm Ltd, with Blonde crosses to 136p/kg for 728kg from Charlie Cadwallader. 948kg Limousin stock bulls to 129p/kg from Mike Halford.

141 CLEAN CATTLE

28 steers sold to av. 193p/kg – Some superb Limousin cross bullocks from Gordon Jones sold to 225p/kg for 644kg (£1449) with Ray Bason's handy-weight selling to 225p/kg for 486kg. Peter Raybould's Limmies were also of note at 211p/kg for 612kg. Angus steers sold to 201p/kg for a most deserving cause!

113 Heifers sold to average 195p/kg – A cracking roan Limmie from Richard Parkes stole the honours when it realised 250p/kg for 502kg. Roger Jordin sold heavier sorts to 241p/kg, 240p/kg and 237p/kg. 516kg black Lims sold to 236p/kg from Henry Yates, with 512kg Lims to the same from the Bason stable who also sold 628kg to £1444.40. Also rans at 51p/kg are also included in the averages.

ONLY 37 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 179P/KG

The shortage of bulls continues but a few suckler bulls beginning to rear their heads.

642kg and 650kg Limousins from Matt Bower sold to 217p/kg and 215p/kg respectively, with 598kg Limousin to 215p/kg from the Yates farmstead and a second to 214p/kg. 568kg Limousins at 11m sold to 210p/kg from Chris Walker. 756kg Limousins from Glyn Breeze totted up well to £1519.56

(201p/kg). Henry Yates gets a mention again, with his Friesian selling to 181p/kg for 586kg. Holsteins sold to 175p/kg for Phil Roberts and Charlie Cadwallader.

WATER CAPITAL GRANTS 2015 AVAILABLE NOW

The application window for grants under the new Countryside Stewardship Water Capital Grants Scheme 2015 opened on 2nd March 2015. The maximum available grant for each farm business is £10,000 and is only available to those within a Catchment Sensitive Farming Priority Target Area. Grants are available for a variety of capital works including gateway relocation, hard bases for livestock drinkers, livestock troughs and associated pipework, livestock and machinery hardcore tracks, water crossings, concrete yards and rainwater goods to name but a few.
