

BRIDGNORTH LIVESTOCK MARKET WEEKLY REPORT – 03.03.20



119 PRIME CATTLE

Once again a smaller entry saw trade mixed with best handyweight cattle dearer and larger wholesaling cattle having to face the music. Trade takes a bit of working out when cattle under 500kg are coming to £150 head more than cattle over 600kg. Small strip loins and smaller high value cuts are what the market requires obviously.

Best steers today were not the crème de la crème and sold to 195p/kg or to £1220 in the lump. A few more decent fleshed steers could have helped fill orders today.

A cracking trade on butchers heifers sold to 257p/kg with 5 others 250p/kg or above. Heavy females sold well if fit enough to £1380.

Bull quality took a large step forward with sucklers selling to 222p/kg, with several others above 200p/kg. Heavy sucklers sold to £1406. Friesian bulls a fair trade selling to 170p/kg.

6 COWS SOLD TO OV.AV. 108p/KG

A fantastic cow trade with 5 Holsteins and 1 Limmo sold to 118p/kg for 676kg, with 896kg and 810kg Holsteins to 114p/kg.
