The steer entry was mixed selling from 109p/kg to 215p/kg or in excess of £1300 in the lump.

Butchers heifers stole the headlines selling to 236p/kg with several past 230p/kg. Heavy females to £1232.

Bull trade at least held its own with few best quality black and whites forward. Suckler bulls sold to 194p/kg with Friesians 149p/kg.

Only 7 cows forward met a sharp trade again with Devon sucklers to 128p/kg and British Blue crosses to 124p/kg. Meat Friesians to 90p/kg but were not assured.


