163 PRIME CATTLE

At last the auctioneer has something positive to write about. Yes, trade was better today with some cattle 10p/kg dearer than recent gloomy days. We are starting from a very low ebb however and trust that this is not just a flash in the pan for everyone's sake. Overall market average was 171p/kg with some very tricky goods forward in places.

Still no steers over 200p/kg but the best sold to 195p/kg with cattle in front of lower dead weight quotations by a bit! A super butchers heifer sold to 240p/kg with more above 200p/kg than recent weeks. Heavy heifers much dearer unless too fat.

More bidders for bulls than any other department and we could easily have sold 100 bulls without affecting prices. No crème de la crème sorts with sucklers to 187p/kg and black and whites to 168p/kg. Plain bulls dearer also.

18 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL SOLD TO AV. 110/KG

Trade remains reasonably sharp in this section with more numbers needed again. Pure Limousins sold to 157p/kg for 676kg with black Lims to 144p/kg for 850kg. Slip Holsteins sold to 116p/kg for 538kg. . Very plain boners down to 60p/kg. 966kg meated Limousin stock bulls to 128p/kg.

101 CLEAN CATTLE

26 Steers sold to ov. av. 173p/kg

Shapey 620kg British Blues from Dave Froggatt sold to 195p/kg, with red Lims from John Johnston to 192p/kg and 190p/kg. Peter Raybould's two best sold to 188p/kg.

75 Heifers sold to ov. av. 183p/kg

Neil Perkins' Limmies at 454kg and 452kg sold to 240p/kg and 228p/kg respectively. Stuart Bebb's 506kg Limousin also sold to 228p/kg with 490kg to 226p/kg from Andrew Craig. Supermarket cattle saw improved trade but there were several also rans keeping the lid on the averages including 50p/kg 'specials'.

62 YOUNG BULLS OV. AV. 158P/KG

More demand on bulls this morning with 25 Holsteins included in the entry. Best sucklers were perhaps not quite the quality of last week but sold to 197p/kg and 193p/kg for 550kg and 564kg Lims from Richard Parkes. Paul Harper sold 568kg Blonde to 190p/kg. British Blue crosses from James Paddock sold to 185p/kg with Charolais to 184p/kg from Phil Roberts. Heavy bulls and lean bulls, whatever their age, met plenty of bidding.

Best meat black and whites sold to 168p/kg from the Paddock stable again.

Lambs up by around £10 per head on last week with the heavier lambs showing the most improvement selling to £120 per head and 266p/kg. Conventional lambs sold to 278p/kg and a small number of hogs to 210p/kg.

Across the board a completely different trade with customers looking to fill requirements with lamb now the hoggets have finally dried up.

Brian Watkins topped the sale at 278p/kg for 37.5kg Texels and plenty of consignments averaging well over £110 per head.

Light weights sold to 260p/kg for 35.5kg with hill breeds 235p/kg to 246p/kg.
