132 PRIME CATTLE

A Sharp trade considering the larger players having taken money out the job this week. Well finished cattle with a bit of shape benefited from the better end of the trade with shapeless cattle facing low values generally.

Mostly Herefords forward in the steer department this morning selling to 128p/kg but with Limousins to 214p/kg, with over thirty month bullocks £1278 in the hump.

The usual strong demand for the best heifers selling to 249p/kg with several others passed 240p/kg. Fit heavy heifers a good trade selling to £1320 as a whole.

Over twice as many bulls as last week met similar returns – a good result. Storming Continentals sold to 215p/kg with seven others 200p/kg or above. Fewer best black and white bulls with Holsteins selling to 169p/kg.

7 CULL COWS SOLD TO AVERAGE 94p/kg

Great to see a few more barrens penned this morning with best Blonde cows selling to 148p/kg for 722kg (£1068.56). Meaty Limousin cows to 120p/kg. Holstein Friesians on the plain side sold pretty well to 74p/kg.

More competition for Farm Assured cows this morning.

16 Steers sold to ov.av. 157p/kg - Not many best sorts penned but a useful trade saw David Jones Limousins selling from 208p/kg – 214p/kg. Charolais crosses from Phillip Terry sold to 186p/kg with average Blondes to 181p/kg from Shropshire & Jones. Phil Terry's Herefords sold to 178p/kg for 558kg.

60 Heifers sold to ov.av. 202p/kg - Well fleshed females in demand with butchers' cattle topping at 249p/kg for handy weight Blondes from Sue Evans. Mrs B took second spot with her 450kg Blue at 246p/kg. Richard Parkes usual quality saw 4 of his Continentals from 240p/kg to 244p/kg. 482kg Limmies sold to 241p/kg from Dave Digwood, 626kg Limousin x Charolais from Richard & Ben Price sold nicely to £1320.86.
