Some fantastic cattle forward once again with a very tidy entry helping viable loads. A sharp trade throughout with buyers short of cattle. We didn't quite achieve the headliner prices but with more commercial types seeing trade dearer!

A small sample of quality steers saw a top of 332p/kg with four others 320p/kg or above. Heavies in shorter supply sold to £2143.

Some superb heifers penned saw a top of 354p/kg with five females 350p/kg and more. Heavier females sold to £2037.

Our show of bulls was tremendous with just a few too lean for every taste. Trade held firm selling to 300p/kg or £2315 in the lump.

A mixed show of cull cows saw great results selling to 238p/kg for 728kg Limousins or £1732.64, with meaty Angus crosses 187p/kg for 738kg (£1380.06).

'Mrs B' put some cracking Limmie and Blue steers in front of the buyers to top at 332p/kg or £2067.20 for 640kg.
