The Supreme Champion Beast 2019 was awarded the Nock Deighton Cup to a Limousin Heifer from Roger Jordin of W Jordin and Sons and was purchased by the judge himself to realise £2,620 or £4.80 p/kg. The Reserve Champion (Manby Bowdler Cup) was another Limousin Heifer from Bob Beaman of GR Beaman & Sons and was purchased by Mr Alan Mulaney of Hartshead Meats, Mossley, Manchester realising £2,227.40 or £3.70p/kg. A reasonable entry of lambs forward for this year's Christmas Show and Sale judged by Mark Perrins of Farmers Fresh. Almost a clean sweep by Lee Preece who triumphed having Champion Single Lamb and the Brian Meredith Cup, Champion pen of Lambs and the George King Cup together with several first, second and thirds.

His top pen 38.5kg realised £4.00 per kilo purchased by Mike and Sarah's Family Butchers, Bridgnorth and 42kg Single lamb 3.75p/kg purchased by Malcolm Wickstead Butchers. The trade throughout the show generally 220p/kg to 250p/kg with several heavy weights over £120 to 59kg - £129 Andrew Preece.

Commercial lambs met a very sharp trade with a market average of 207p/kg to 229p/kg, 45.5kg Texels. All lambs over 39kg averaged £90 per head and over 50kg £100 per head. Lighter weights 31kg sold to 210p/kg, with hill lambs 185p/kg to 195p/kg.
