### 91 PRIME CATTLE

A decent entry of cattle met a firm trade but no dearer than last week’s flier! Cattle quality was a little mixed but with some very good cattle penned amongst them. 20 cattle sold above £2000 today to a marked high of 385p/kg.

A dozen steers saw a high of 340p/kg with heavies to £2316 in the lump.

Similar numbers of females to last week saw the best-selling to 385p/kg with heavier heifers to £2248.

One less bull than Christmas show day sold to a top of 330p/kg with heavies adding up nicely to £2566 in the lump.

### 63 CLEAN CATTLE

#### 12 STEERS SOLD TO OV AV 301P/KG

Andrew and Neale Dalton were top dog here with their 582kg Limmie selling to 340p/kg with Mrs B in hot pursuit selling her 676kg Limousin cross to 332p/kg and her 704kg to 329p/kg or £2316.16. A 724kg Hereford bullock sold to 276p/kg from Rob Watkins.

#### 51 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV AV 300P/KG

The usual superstars from Evans Curdale excelled at 385p/kg and 382p/kg for 540kg and 542kg respectively with a third to 360p/kg for 5632 – all Limmies. Handyweights from Lloyd Parkes sold to 380p/kg for 514kg Limousin with a 492kg model to 370p/kg. Charolais heifers from Mr Willan won the headage stakes at 644kg to £2247.56 (349p/kg).

#### 28 BULLS SOLD TO OV AV 276P/KG

The ‘Peaton three’ from Howard and Colin Fish took the plaudits with Limousins to 330p/kg, 326p/kg and 308p/kg. Tom White was in town again selling his best to 318p/kg for 704kg (£2238.72), with the Powell family selling their Blondes to 312p/kg for 668kg and 750kg to 307p/kg (£2302.50).

Richard Skellern sold his 832kg Limousin cross to £2412.80 only to be pipped by the Kirton’s selling to 312p/kg for 822kg for a pure Limousin.

A very mixed entry of lambs sold to a trade which reflected the quality. A sale average of 300p/kg with a price range from 240p/kg to 350p/kg.

Graham Davies' Texels took top spot at 350p/kg for 44kg, closely followed at 349p/kg by Pete Morris' Beltex 45kg. Generally lighter weights and meat hit the higher prices per kilo, 38kg to 318p/kg from Ian Moreton and Roddy Yapp's 35kg sold at 316p/kg.

Heavy weights generally over £160 to a high of £185 for 70kg Suffolks from Tony Davies, who's Suffolk lambs averaged over £180 per head. Keep these lambs coming, more could be sold every week, with no adverse effect on trade.
