All buyers in attendance today, although not firing on all cylinders, with the trade in early 2022 difficult to judge. As per usual best finished sorts easiest to sell, especially with a bit of shape.

Only two steers forward saw the best selling to 218p/kg or £1425 in the lump. More steers were required especially with meat and shape.

A useful bunch of heifers forward saw the cream selling to 295p/kg, with five others in the 280p/kg bracket. 600kg, finished with shape, sold to £1743 in the lump.

Continental easier to sell than the black and whites today, with heavy sucklers selling to 260p/kg with others 250p/kg and above with £1840 in the lump achieved. No black and whites above 190p/kg this morning, so producers will possibly hold off and get a bit more weight into them - if feed prices allow?

With ewe numbers well down nationally over 900 ewes penned in Bridgnorth and trade up on last week, averaging £90 to a top price of £170 for Texel ewes from J Bond.

Heavy meated ewes easily sold with cross-bred Texel ewes over £140, Suffolks to £142 and North Country Mules to £129.50 with several consignments top end over £120.

As recent months not all the ewes sold in Bridgnorth are lowland breeds, pen after pen of hill ewes selling to £91 Beulah £74 Wenn, £84 Improved Welsh and smaller, ¾ meated Swales at £61.

Leaner ewes look very well sold, with Mules £80 to £90, Continentals £90 to £100 and smaller quite plain cross-bred ewes £70.
