A great entry of clean cattle with some superb quality amongst them but with a massive deficit in bull numbers. Trade was great on best quality sorts especially if they were the right weight. Second quality breaking up sorts held their values well but the price had to face the music of a depressed wholesale trade.

Similar entries of steers to last week saw very few best bullocks within the preferred weight range selling to 204p/kg or £1387.56 for overweight's.

A fantastic go on butcher's heifers selling to 259p/kg, with two others 250p/kg or above. Handyweight heifers selling to £1357.16 coming to more per head than heavier cattle.

Only 27 bulls with 3 buyers leaving totally empty handed. Trade firm with Continentals to 210p/kg on two occasions and also 207p/kg. Dairy bulls to an improved trade to 169p/kg. Many more bulls required to satisfy demand.

3 cows forward today following last week's bonanza sold to improved returns with plain British Blue cows to 104p/kg and Hereford crosses 99p/kg.

19 STEERS SOLD TO OV.AV. 182P/KG

A super Blonde steer from Phillip Corfield topped this section at 204p/kg for 620kg with James Griffin selling 548kg Limousins to 200p/kg and handyweights 476kg to 199p/kg from John Westwood. 746kg Blondes from Frank Millichamp added up to £1387.56 and extras to £1361.

80 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 206P/KG

Long distance traveller Mr Wynn sold a lovely run of Limmie Heifers to 259p/kg for 524kg (£1357.16) and another to 245p/kg. Richard Parkes usual sample sold to 246p/kg, 249p/kg 250p/kg and 254pp/kg. Matt Bowers run sold to 248p/kg, Sue Evans (Curdale Farm) to 247p/kg and Mrs B to 245p/kg. Many heifers above £1,300 in the lump today. Larger, plainer cattle hard to sell as previously stated.
