164 PRIME CATTLE

Although trade is not as we would wish, there was an improvement in prices generally today. Good quality, finished but lean cattle saw demand perhaps 5p/kg firmer, with thicker sorts holding values well. The overall average was 175p/kg including over agers and many Holstein bulls. 14 buyers were present.

A useful show of steers saw the best to 218p/kg for handy weights with a top price per head of £1442.32. Butchers heifers found more keen punters and sold to 245p/kg, with more cattle above 230p/kg than recent sales. Heavy heifers sold to just below £1300 in the lump.

Our bull entry was once again very mixed. There were plenty of bidders for the worst end and some quality suckler bulls up to 600kg would have met a good trade if there had been any. Best available Continentals topped at 204p/kg. Holsteins sold to 152p/kg. Friesians to 175p/kg.

35 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL SOLD TO OV. AV. 102P/KG

A mixed bag of cows saw trade no worse with best quality British Blue cows to 172p/kg. Meat Holsteins sold to 114p/kg. Plain cows sold around the 80p/kg unless very small or ultra-lean. Brown Swiss stock bulls to 88p/kg.

40 steers sold to average 182p/kg. Ed Roberts' handy 534kg Limousin sold to 218p/kg with 540kg to 217p/kg from Gordon Jones. 592kg Lims from Gerald Kincaid took third spot at 208p/kg. 580kg Blondes from Millichamp Bros sold to 204p/kg. Friesian steers sold to 164p/kg for 658kg from EW Boden & Sons. 806kg Devons to £1442 from Richard Preece.

76 heifers sold to average 188p/kg. 460kg Blondes from Brian and Dan Watkins sold to 245p/kg. Ray Bason's useful run of 12 was headed by 2 Limousins at 235p/kg and others 232p/kg and 231p/kg. 538kg Lims from John Cantrill sold to 232p/kg with Ed Roberts also selling to 230p/kg.

48 YOUNG BULLS SOLD OV AV. 151P/KG

23 Holsteins were forward in our entry today, with many bulls above 16 months of age. 610kg Limousin bulls from Roger Tomley headed the day at 204p/kg (22m). 588kg Blondes (23m) sold to 192p/kg from Forest Vale Growers with 730kg Charolais from Glyn Breeze to 191p/kg at 17m.

Mary Beaumont's Friesian sold to 175p/kg at 508kg (15m) with only one other black and white above 150p/kg.

There were 6 bidders for bulls today.
