An improved trade with too few cattle to satisfy demand and buyers leaving needing more stock. The Easter Primestock Show encouraged a nice entry of handy butchers' cattle along with some useful bulls. More commercial clean cattle saw improved returns.

A small show of steers sold to 238p/kg with heavy bullocks to £1439. More well-finished steers are required each week.

Butchers' heifers saw a sharp level of trade all through, with the best to 255p/kg and many over 240p/kg.

There were some very tidy suckler bulls presented as the time of year for spring born bulls is almost upon us. Best bulls sold to 227p/kg, with more over 200p/kg than recent weeks. Holstein trade was good again, with black and whites selling to 178p/kg.

Light weights possibly a little dearer with very ordinary hoggs 30kg to 35kg over 180p/kg to 187p/kg from Rob Rose. 35.5kg to 187.5p/kg from Gary Shorthouse and 33kg from Phil Jordan to 186p/kg.
