139 PRIME CATTLE

Several buyers not needing cattle today which would reflect the type of trade we are dealing with at the moment. Bull trade was particularly tricky with even the black and white section seeing values depressed. Well-finished, good quality heifers and steers were generally in demand, with a heifer average of 203p/kg which was reasonably satisfying with the way things are.

Best quality steers sold to 209p/kg, with the heaviest available to £1246. Several second string bullocks forward helping to depreciate averages.

A firm trade on best butcher's sorts sold to a high of 245p/kg, with heavy females to £1316 in the lump.

Similar bull numbers saw only one bull sell above 200p/kg to 203p/kg for handy-weight Continentals. Heavier Continentals sold to £1310 in the lump.

Friesian bulls sold to 186p/kg for a square Friesian with plainer types less money.

5 CULL COWS

Some good meat cows forward sae 822kg Blondes selling to 138p/kg, with Simmental crosses to 123p/kg for 708kg.

Not enough cows for buyers to get started today.

78 CLEAN CATTLE

Only 12 Steers sold to ov.av.168p/kg – Super finished Limousin steers from the Sandells family topped here at 209p/kg for 556kg, with a Charolais from a very deserving cause selling to 196p/kg to £1246.56 at 636kg. Paul Kent's non-assured Limousin also sold to 196p/kg for 542kg.

66 Heifers sold to ov.av. 203p/kg – Buyers were definitely looking for handy-weight cattle today, with 450-560kg easiest sold. Roger Jordin's run of eight sold to 245p/kg for 514kg, with 478kg from Steve Perkins selling to 243p/kg. Richard Parke's best sold to 241p/kg for 504kg. 526kg Lims from Dave Chilton sold to 236p/kg. Heavier Continentals from Robin Morris returning to the fold added up to £1316.70 for 630kg.

61 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 167P/KG

504kg Limousins from Mark Jones sold to 203p/kg, with 532kg Blondes to 199p/kg from Shropshire & Jones. Blues from Ed Green sold to 194p/kg for 632kg. 712kg Limmies from Henry Yates sold to £1310.08.
