#### **125 PRIME CATTLE**

Having landed back safely from the Welsh coast, the regular auctioneer returns to see that things had been left in safe hands. With this in mind, there were a sprinkling more bulls but with clean numbers very tight. A ring full of buyers present easily mopped up our entry, with quality clean cattle very dear and bulls in line with recent markets but trade a little fragile in places.

A handful of steers sold to 232p/kg or £1345 for handyweights. All other bullocks were dairy bred and/or over 30 months.

Useful runs of butchers heifers met a roaring trade with buyers short of numbers for regular orders. Best females sold to 250p/kg with ten others 240p/kg or more. Heavy heifers sold to £1412 in the lump.

Plenty of orders for well-fleshed bulls. 600kg and below selling to 225p/kg. Heavier breaking sorts found buyers more discerning with only the best above 200p/kg. A good trade on well-finished Holsteins selling to 167p/kg. Heavy Continentals to £1527.

#### **ONLY 7 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL**

Not much go in this trade but we have seen this before during the summer holidays. Peter Raybould's Limousin cow sold to 113p/kg for 598kg. 828kg Holsteins with a shade of meat and belly to 98p/kg. Ultra-lean Limousin cross stock bulls to 80p/kg. Farm Assurance is helpful for the time being.

#### **69 CLEAN CATTLE**

8 steers sold to av. 175p/kg — A cracking British Blue from Neil Perkins soared to 232p/kg for 580kg. Blonde cross steers 644kg to 188p/kg from H Snelson Ltd, with Dave Cantrill's Hereford crosses to 172p/kg. 33m Holsteins to 126p/kg on the shapeless side included in the averages.

**50 heifers sold to av. 206p/kg** – Greg & Gary Thomas stole the honours here with their 488kg Limmie to 250p/kg. A cracking run from Rich Parkes saw two handyweights to 249p/kg. 574kg Blondes from IGC Morris added up well at 246p/kg (£1412) with 626kg Limousins to £1462 from Andrew Dalton.


#### 56 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 175P/KG
