117 PRIME CATTLE

Once again, a shortage of beasts materialised with a handful more clean and a smaller bull entry forward. The live market was well in front of the diminished dead-weight equivalent once again (no stressful cameras either!), with buyers needing more cattle to fulfil orders. Plenty of cattle too lean for most tastes- many of which would have been suited for our Friday sale!

Only a handful of steers penned to a buoyant trade with Continentals to 231p/kg or £1402 in the lump.

There were some nice handy-weight butchers heifers about but very few of the very best and more could easily have sold. Limousins sold to 246p/kg.

A definite shortage of bulls today but with those attending rewarded well. Well-finished cattle easier to sell as normal with shop bulls to 227p/kg, with heavy Continentals passed 200p/kg on several occasions.

Some plainer brethren in the black and white department, with best Holsteins available to 169p/kg.

ONLY 7 COWS FORWARD sold to an overall average of 106p/kg. Best Limousin cows sold to 169p/kg for 660kg, with British Blue cross cows to 124p/kg. Plain steakers to 95p/kg for Holstein Friesians 636kg.

MORE COWS & STOCK BULLS NEEDED

74 CLEAN CATTLE

13 steers sold to average 197p/kg – A nice run of five Limousins sold to 231p/kg and 230p/kg for a ‘deserving cause’, with heavy steers to £1402.80 from the same home. Hereford x Lims sold to 201p/kg from John Gore.

MORE STEERS REQUIRED- WE ARE ACHIEVING ABOVE DEAD PRICE EQUIVALENT

61 heifers sold to av. 197p/kg – Quite a few plain cattle here helped to pull the average back. This is a meat market and the buyers are prepared to bid well for fit cattle. Mrs Edwards sold his sweet heifers to 246p/kg for 440kg, with 528kg to 241p/kg from Matt & Wendy Bower. A useful load from the ‘Chilton ranch’ topped at 241p/kg for 484kg, with Richard Parkes selling to 239p/kg for 534kg Blondes.

43 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 174P/KG

Mrs Edwards excelled in this section also with her quick 498kg Limmo selling to 227p/kg. Roger Tomley and Mr Davies sold to 209p/kg, with Peter Kirton selling to 208p/kg with his heavies just short of £1500 at 18m old.

Best black and whites were hard to come by and sold to 169p/kg from Peter Gore, with Mr Davies selling to 166p/kg and 165p/kg.
