#### 96 PRIME CATTLE

No more cattle forward although bull numbers did swell a little. A sharp trade especially on the clean cattle with butchers cattle especially sought after. As many cattle over 300p/kg than we have seen for some time with bulls selling to £2000 once again.

Decent steer numbers sold to a high of 282p/kg with heavier steers to £1921 in the lump.

Depleted heifer numbers sold to a roaring trade selling to 321p/kg or £1802 in the lump. Eleven cattle in total sold to 300p/kg or above.

An improved number of bulls penned this morning saw a similar level of trade with perhaps the edge slightly off compared to last Tuesday. Heavy Limousins sold to £2000 or 260p/kg with a mixed sample of dairy bulls selling to 206p/kg.

A small entry of 3 cows saw a good level of demand with 716p/kg thick Herefords selling to 156p/kg or £1116.96 in the lump.

#### 17 STEERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 257P/KG

A superb young Angus steer from Meadowley Zoo topped at 282p/kg for 620kg with Simmentals from John Cantrill selling to 280p/kg. Handyweight Bazadaise steers from distance traveller Mike Evans sold to 270p/kg. The heaviest Limmie from the Cantrills added up nicely to £1920.96.

#### 39 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 273P/KG

Evans (Curdale) topped the day at 321p/kg in a lively heifer market with their best red Limousin. A 574kg shapely Blue hit 314p/kg or £1802.36 for the same producer. Second spot went to Roger Jordin's best at 320p/kg for 490kg with two others from the Jordin's in the 300 pences. Two Limousins from the Parkes family sold to 316p/kg. Tim Madeley and Mrs B both sold their best to 300p/kg plus.

#### 40 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 225P/KG

A great run of red Limmies from Messrs James sold to a high of 260p/kg for 670kg with their tremendous 800kg bull to £2000 exactly. 742kg Limmies from John Hewitt sold to 253p/kg or £1877.26 with heavy Charolais from Charlie Cadwallader selling to £1893.12 for 816kg.

Meaty Friesians from the Woolrich's sold to 206p/kg for 528kg with plenty of belly about in the Black & White section this morning.
