There was a little more demand today with the shortage of prime cattle taking effect and causing trade to firm. Heifers averaged just short of 200p/kg, with heavy bullocks to near £1600. Best handy weights were easiest sold with plenty of customers for lean, well-finished beasts.

762kg Limousin steers sold to £1593 with very few good bullocks forward. Many cattle were over 30 months once again with some over 36 months. Best butchers heifers met a sharp trade with many over-weight for most tastes. 239p/kg was top price with six above 230p/kg.

A poorer bull sample saw a firm trade with 686kg Limousins to £1360. Handy weight shop bulls sold to 218p/kg with Friesians to 174p/kg.

#### 10 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL

An improved trade here also with numbers reduced in most recent live auction marts.

Young Limousin cross cows sold to 159p/kg for 690kg, with two others above 150p/kg from David Bibbey. Steaking cows were not the best and had belly selling from 89p/kg-99p/kg. 1216kg Blonde stock bulls sold to 100p/kg.
