More cattle forward saw trade a little firmer with some better types forward. Over-weight and over-fat sorts were still tricky however, with some cattle better suited to the store ring forward helping to reduce averages. We are hoping the trade is bottoming out, with yarded cattle starting to slow up nationally in the near future.

A good entry of steers saw Herefords selling to 209p/kg and heavies to £1294.08.

Butchers heifers saw a lift in values selling to 246p/kg, with heavy heifers selling just short of £1400. Commercial heifers also a little sharper if not too fat.

Once again, a fair bull trade with plenty of buyers looking for well-finished, young cattle from 500-650kg. Suckler bulls sold to 223p/kg with heavier bulls to £1326 in the lump. Very few good black and whites forward sold to 152p/kg.

11 COWS FORWARD

70% of our cows were not assured with no good quality cows forward. Assured Friesians sold to 95p/kg for 688kg from Robin Maydew.

122 CLEAN CATTLE

45 steers sold to av. 175p/kg – Malcolm Davies' Herefords sold to 200p/kg and 209p/kg, with Gerald Kincaid's run of Continentals to 208p/kg. Blondes from Richard Milner 566kg to 201p/kg. Peter Raybould's Limmies added up to £1294.00, with David Whiteman's heavy Simmental to £1260.60.

77 heifers sold to av. 192p/kg – A super run from Dave Chilton sold to 246p/kg, 244p/kg and 240p/kg all handy-weights. 498kg sold to 239p/kg from Roger Jordin, with 552kg to 238p/kg from Richard Parkes. 594kg Blondes sold to 238p/kg from Frank Millichamp to total £1413.72.


Black and whites sold to 152p/kg from Phil Roberts.
