145 PRIME CATTLE

Trade held up well today with some good quality cattle forward. Just short of 100 clean cattle was pleasing with a ring full of buyers to boot. The Muslim fraternity were missing in the bull department today as Ramadan comes to an end.

A better sample of bullocks forward saw best quality to 222p/kg or £1393 in the lump. Second string steers saw trade dearer.

Butchers heifers saw strong demand selling to a market high of 245p/kg, with heavy females to £1298. Well-finished cattle of whatever shape sold more easily.

Fewer well-finished handy-weight suckler bulls penned this morning. Best shapey but very lean sorts were a little harder to sell, with meat Friesians holding values. Continentals sold to 205p/kg and Friesians to 157p/kg. Heavy bulls struggling over £1200 generally.

17 COWS SOLD TO OV. AV. 114P/KG.

Some good meat cows forward without being the very best saw trade very firm.716kg British Blue crosses sold to 159p/kg, with Holsteins 582kg to 128p/kg. Angus x cows also saw 128p/kg at 832kg.

96 CLEAN CATTLE

Only 26 steers sold to av. 181p/kg – Limousins and British Blues from the Wardle stable stole the limelight at 222p/kg and 207p/kg, with Charolais from John Johnston selling to 201p/kg at 574kg. 584kg Limousins sold to 200p/kg from Rita Corfield. Holstein bullocks to 155p/kg from Tom Hill.

70 heifers sold to av. 200p/kg — Two cracking Limmies from Steve Perkins sold to 245p/kg and 235p/kg respectively to top the day, with David Thomas selling to 243p/kg and 239p/kg for his two Limousins. Matt Bower's nice run sold to 236p/kg on two occasions and to 235p/kg. IGC Morris also sold Lims to 235p/kg.

49 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 159P/KG

More lean, heavy bulls forward saw trade difficult, with orders for handier weight, thicker cattle unable to be fulfilled. 574kg Limousins from Stuart Bebb sold to 205p/kg, with handyweight 528kg Blondes to 204p/kg from Brian Watkins. Shapey 600kg British Blues to 200p/kg from Edward Green. Colin Evans topped the black and white department at 157p/kg for 560kg, with Glyn Breeze achieving 153p/kg for 590kg Holsteins.
