60 PRIME CATTLE

Very short of cattle, but with local abattoirs shut down for refurbishment fewer cattle were required. Clean cattle about held their own, with bulls seeing a firm trade on everything.

A handful of mainly dairy-bred steers sold to 230p/kg with Hereford steers to 225p/kg. Heavy Herefords sold to £1730.

Not many best heifers penned today sold to 301p/kg. Overages sold to £1691 in the lump.

A useful sample of bulls saw the first sold to 265p/kg. Some very well-finished, heavy Shorthorn-cross bulls added up nicely to £1978.92. Black and whites trade was sharp selling to 215p/kg on two occasions.

Two cows forward saw young Limmie cows to 199p/kg for 818kg or £1611.46, with leaner Blonde-crosses to 187p/kg.

31 CLEAN CATTLE

7 STEERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 220P/KG

Burwarton Farms took top spot here at 230p/kg for their handyweight 538kg homebred Limousin. 722kg red Herefords from Keith Alderson sold to 225p/kg with his 790kg Hereford to £1730.10 in the lump. More well-finished steers could have easily sold.

24 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 240P/KG

A Limousin from Dan Watkins was top price of the day at 301p/kg for 490kg. 40-month Herefords sold nicely to £1690.60 from Ian Braithwaite, with Charolais-crosses from Dave Preece to £1687.56.

29 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 225P/KG

Home-bred Limousins from David Digwood shone at 265p/kg for 542kg. Handyweight Limmie/Blondes sold to 249p/kg from Dan Watkins. Heavier beef Shorthorns sold to 248p/kg for 670kg with his 828kg Shorthorn adding up to £1978.92.

Black and Whites sold to 215p/kg from Dave Preece and John Parrott.

A larger entry and an improved trade averaging 325p/kg with increased demand across all weights.

As per recent weeks heavy-weight lambs remain well sold and, even with a customer missing, trade held firm on lambs over 44kg, with 61kg lambs selling to just shy of £200 from Ray Bache and a consignment of Suffolk x Mule and Texel lambs from Tony Davies averaging 48kg and £158 a head.

Handier weight lambs to 346p/kg for 41kg Texels from Pete Kirton. Butchers were looking for quality and prepared to pay for well-finished, shapely lambs.

As you would expect the week before the forthcoming Qurbani festival, lambs under 40kg were easily sold with 37.5kg Texels from Mark Steele at 339.5p/kg.

An entry of small, young store lambs averaged £79, with clean headed Texel x Mule lambs from John Lawley at £87. Plenty of interest in stores with the buoyant fat trade currently underpinning the stores.

STORE CATTLE

Steers sold to £1190 and heifers £1160 for an entry of generally stronger dairy-bred stores.

Shapier Limousin steers sold to 257p/kg for 16 month-old, weighing 370kg from Rob Wilcock. With both Simmental and British Blues from Tony England well over £1000 at £1160 and £1190. British White steers from Martin Osborne at £1060 and 217p/kg

Heifers to £1160 for 500kg weight for Limousin cross, with 32 month-old British Blues to £1080. No suckler bred animals forward, hence a top price of 323p/kg for 19 month-old Limousins.

A single cow and calf realised £1040 and Shorthorn cows running with the bull sold at £940.
